

Lifeguarding Course

An American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is set to begin February 28, 2010 at the Hudson High Pool. This course will include waterfront lifeguarding, first aid, and CPR requirements needed to work as a lifeguard in New York State.

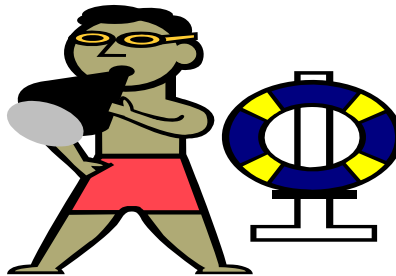
Class Dates: Sunday Mornings 8:00AM - 12:00PM

February 28, 2010 - May 2, 2010

No class on April 4, 2010 (Easter)

******Class attendance at all sessions is mandatory!!!!******

Students must be age 15 by the conclusion date, May 2, 2010 in order to participate in class.



Pre-requisites:* **1.** Swim (550 yards) *continuously* using the **front crawl** (200 yards), **breaststroke** (200 yards), and (150) yards of either the front crawl or breast stroke. **2.** Swim 20 yards in water, surface diving 7-10 feet retrieve a 10 pound object, return to the surface and return the object to the starting point, and exit the water within 1 minute and 40 seconds. **3.** Swim 5 yards submerge and retrieve 3 dive rings placed 5 yards apart in 4-7 feet of water and resurface swimming 5 yards to the side of pool.

Cost: \$210.00 (Make checks payable to the Hudson City School District) Cost includes textbook, pocket mask, and American Red Cross certificates upon successful completion of course requirements.
