**Community Eligibility Program Update Presentation:** Cathy Drumm, Director of Food Service explained Hudson City School District’s food service program. All programs are self-sustaining through state and federal reimbursement, which explains why the Food Service Program is not an item in the annual school budget. **School Improvement Report:** Coordinator of School Improvement, April Prestipino, informed the Board on the following:

- Math Assessment refusals district-wide for this school year are about the same as last year. There were a number of last minute refusals, which administration had to accommodate by finding a suitable location to house those additional students not taking the assessment. The refusals do not affect government funding.
- May 17<sup>th</sup> Professional Development Day agenda is ready.
- The agenda for Summer Institute is also ready – and jam-packed with worthwhile workshops.
- Computer-based field testing for ELA is almost ready for roll-out in grades 6 and 7.

**Superintendent's Report:** Superintendent Suttmeier gave an update on the following:

- **Vision Year 2020 Capital Project** – Rhinebeck Architecture will be sharing the MCSIS expansion plan in detail on May 23, 2016 at 6 p.m. in the JHS Cafeteria. On June 6, 2016 at 6 p.m. they will return for a presentation on the Athletic Fields. Community discussion is welcomed at both presentations.
- **2016-2017 School Budget** – Dr. Suttmeier and Sharifa Carbon, School Business Administrator, presented the proposed 2016-2017 School Budget to the Rotary Club on May 2, 2016. There were approximately 18 rotary members present, who gave positive feedback. Dr. Suttmeier and Mrs. Carbon will be hosting a spotlight on WGXC Radio on Wednesday, May 11, 2016. A community forum will be held on Tuesday, May 10 at 6:30 at JLE. Information is also available and streaming on all available social media outlets.
- **Utica National School Safety of Excellence Award** – Dr. Suttmeier presented the Board with a plaque from Utica National Insurance.
