**COORDINATOR OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT REPORT**

- Teacher lists for Summer Institute are being finalized. The number of teachers signed up is less than last year (85) due to the limited funds available this year. Everyone is able to attend at least one of their choices. There are waiting lists for some offerings.
- The District is learning more about AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination). Administrators are attending a summer training. Mrs. Prestipino is scheduled to attend regional trainings in order to share more about the program in hopes of having the AVID program in Hudson.
- Mrs. Prestipino has been researching for an App for Hudson CSD. The HCSD App will improve community communication by using current District newsfeeds and communication outlets. The App will replace Blackboard Connect, and not cost any more than what the District is already paying. Various Apps have been researched. A mobile-friendly website is also being researched.

A. Capital Project Phase II:

- The monthly Capital Project meeting was held today. The project is still on schedule for September.


