WHEREAS, the evaluation system is designed to measure teacher and principal effectiveness based on performance, including measures of achievement and evidence of educator effectiveness in meeting New York State teacher standards;

WHEREAS, by September 1, 2011, the Board of Education must adopt an APPR plan for classroom teachers in the common branch subjects who teach English Language Arts and/or Mathematics to students in grades 4 through 8, and the building principals of the schools in which those teachers are employed;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Hudson City School District, on a motion by Mr. Merante, with a second by Ms. Frank, that the attached document shall constitute the District's annual professional performance review plan for teachers and principals subject to Education Law Section 3012-c.
