## Vision 2020 Goals

*The Hudson City SD, in partnership with our community, advances the intellectual, social and emotional development of all students to prepare them for college, career and citizenship.*

### Vision 2020 Goals

#### **GOAL 1 - Raise the Bar**

- 85% or higher district graduation rate for all students\* group
- 30% or higher all students\* group achieves 75% CC ELA and 80% CC Math Regents Exams
- 90% or higher Freshman & Sophomore students attain no less than 6 credits each year
- 30% or higher all students\* group meets or exceeds NYS CC 3 - 8 ELA & Math proficiency targets
- 65% avg. or higher K-2 students meet or exceed Fountas & Pinnell reading level expectations

#### **GOAL 2 - Close the Gap**

- 70% avg. or higher building graduation rate for all subgroups\*\*
- 90% HS students accrue at least 3 college credits or 1 career (vocational) credit
- 25% avg. or higher 3-8 students meet or exceed NYS CC ELA/Math proficiency targets for all subgroups\*\*
- 70% avg. or higher Gr. 2 students meet or exceed Fountas & Pinnell reading level expectations

#### **GOAL 3 - Align Curriculum & Instruction**

- 30% or higher all students\* group meets or exceeds Level 3 on Gr. 3 - 8 CC aligned ELA/Math benchmark exams
- 30% or higher all students\* group achieves 75% CC ELA and 80% CC Math Regents Exams
- 100% students engaged in rigorous, differentiated and challenging curriculum that prepares them for college and career as evidenced by classroom observations and meeting/exceeding district goals
- 100% K-12 Curricula mapped and implemented to provide a guaranteed, viable curriculum to students as evidenced by Rubicon Atlas and classroom observations and meeting/exceeding district goals

#### **GOAL 4 - Promote Social Emotional Development**

- 80% or higher students have parent/guardian attend parent-teacher meetings and/or report card conferences
- 80% or higher students engaged in extracurricular, athletic, and/or community service in grades 7 - 12
- 80% or higher students engaged in community partnerships (mentorships, internships and/or career/community service opportunities)
- 80% or higher students adhering to Code of Conduct in each school

\*Includes students placed outside of the district (i.e., SWD, The Bridge)

\*\*Includes State measured categories: (i.e., Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, Asian, White, SWD, LEP, etc.)
