Instructions for Mandatory Hudson City School District Web-based Online Safety and Health Training

Please complete these mandatory online trainings on (or before) opening day but no later than November 1, 2018

To complete online training:

- Open a web browser to: http://courses.theneedhamgroup.com
- At the login page, enter your full name (this will be printed on your course completion certificate).
- If you have an email address, that may be entered as well.
- Select **Hudson City School District** from the dropdown menu.
- Enter the following password:

hcsd2015

- Select "instructional staff" or "non-instructional staff."
- Click on the name of the course you need to complete.
- You will view a video presentation of the material and then take a quiz.
- After you have received a passing score, a completion certificate appears on the screen to be printed. If you entered an email address, a copy of the certificate will be emailed to you.

Here are the MANDATORY trainings ALL STAFF must take:

- SAVE / School Emergency Procedure Training 2018-2019 (Approx. 30 min.)
 - Harassment in Schools and DASA Update Training (Approx. 45 min.)
 - Hazard Communications and Right to Know Training (Approx. 25 min.)

You DO NOT need to take any other courses offered on the website.

Once you have successfully completed each training, you and the district will be notified.

Additional training ONLY for REQUIRED staff*

*Health Office Personnel, Athletic Personnel including lifeguards, PE Instructors and coaches, Custodial/Maintenance, School Safety and selected Staff**.

**Selected staff, as determined by the health offices, is staff that will have contact with students with diagnosed blood disorders or special needs that increase the employee's risk of exposure.
