

BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATION BYLAW

Under the Education Law, a member of the Board of Education may resign his/her office by doing so at a district meeting, or by filing a written resignation with the District (BOCES) Superintendent. The resignation will become effective only upon the approval of the District Superintendent and filing with the school district clerk.

In addition, a Board member may resign his/her office by filing his/her resignation with the District Clerk. The effective date of the resignation must be within thirty (30) days after the date of filing.
