

**SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS BYLAW**

The powers given to the Board of Education by law must be exercised as a Board at a properly convened session or meeting. Such meetings shall be open to the public, except where in the discretion of the Board the subject matter demands an executive session.

Public participation at any open meeting shall be encouraged by the Board but is permitted at the sole discretion of the Board and, if permitted, the participation may be limited in time.
