

VOTING METHOD BYLAW

All proper motions or resolutions recorded and put to vote require for adoption a majority of the full Board regardless of the number present and voting. Exceptions to this requirement are:

- a. A designated textbook cannot be superseded within 5 years except by a four-fifths (4/5) vote of the Board.
- b. No relative by blood or marriage to a member of the Board may be employed in a teaching position and/or in a non-certificated position except on consent of four-fifths (4/5) of the members of the Board.
- c. Standardization on a particular type of equipment or supplies shall be by a three-fifths (3/5) vote of the members affirming such need.

All actions requiring a vote can be conducted by voice, show of hands or roll call. Proxy vote is prohibited. The vote of each member shall be recorded on each action of the Board.
