TRANSPORTATION TO A CHILD CARE LOCATION

A student of the Hudson City School District may be transported to or from the location of a child care provider if the student's legal residence and the child care provider's location are both within the boundaries of the Hudson City School District or special arrangements have been made by the Superintendent of the District. Parents must complete a "Child Care Transportation Request Form." (CTRF). Once on file, these are the transportation arrangements that will remain in effect for the student until they are revoked by the parent in writing or the end of the school year, at which time or the start of the new school year, the student will either ride their regularly assigned bus or the parent can fill out a new CTRF. Once alternate transportation has been arranged, the school staff will provide the student with a new or temporary pass that is to be given to the bus driver of the new route, letting them know that the student is currently riding their bus with District approval.
